Equestrian Australia (EA) has revoked the EA Hendra Vaccination By-Law. The panel (commissioned by the EA Board) will remain in place to complete a full assessment on the risk that the Hendra virus creates for EA events nationally.

### **Reverse Qualification**

Applies to International and National

A reverse qualification is triggered by two consecutive Cross Country eliminations or a total of three Cross Country eliminations within 12 months rolling period of time in competitions EvA95 and above.

For this purpose the relevant reasons of elimination on Cross Country would be:

- a) Three refusals... XC-R
- b) Fall of Horse or Athlete... XC-FH or XC-FR
- c) Dangerous riding...XC-DR

Please check results and be mindful when entering competitions. If the Combination (horse & rider) or the horse has been eliminated twice consecutively or three times in 12 months.

*The horse (or combination if applicable) is required to obtain at least one MER, at the level below the level that triggered Reverse Qualification, before competing at the previous level.*

Codes for Cross Country Elimination

XC-FH... Fall of Horse

XC-FR... Fall of Rider

XC-R... Refusals (3 or more)

XC-DR...Dangerous Riding

XC-AH...Abuse of Horse

XC-OT...Other, error of course etc

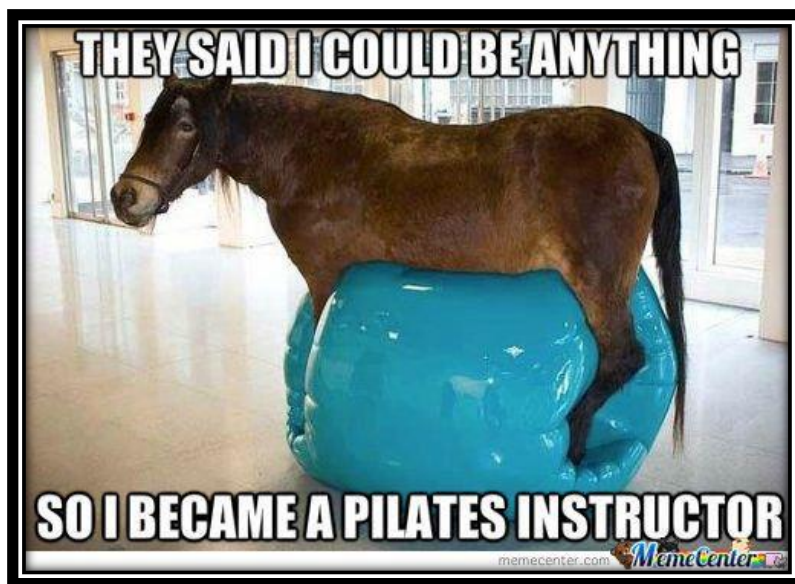

3. Judges decision is final, however, if a dispute arises, the competitor may pay \$50 to the disputes committee as deposit for consideration to clear the dispute. If the judges decision is overruled the competitor will be refunded his/her \$50 deposit.
4. Riders to be ready to compete when called by the steward. In the event a rider refuses to start after three calls he or she may be disqualified.
