TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. DUE TO Equestrian COVID COMPLIANCE EVERYONE ENTERING THE GROUNDS MUST HAVE DOWNLOADED THE NOMINATE EQUESTRIAN APP TO ENABLE SCANNING AT THE ENTRY TO THE GROUNDS.
2. HORSE DECLARATIONS MUST BE FILLED OUT ON GLOBAL ENTRIES.
3. FILL IN THE COVID CHECK-IN ON GLOBAL.
4. ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE CURRENT FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF EA OR TOOWOOMBA JUMP CLUB.
5. Horses are allowed 3 starts per day.
6. Horses can compete in 2 Championships on Sunday.
7. **IQ qualifiers are SUNDAY only - 1 class per height may be used as an IQ qualifier.**
8. Draws will be posted on Global. Riders are expected to adhere to draw order.
9. First Aid will be in attendance on both days.
10. A, B, C classes will be run concurrently, and horse/rider combination may only compete in one.
11. The TJC Organising Committee reserves the right to alter classes and the program as they deem necessary.
12. The TJC reserves the right to refuse any nomination as they deem appropriate.
13. The competition/event will be run under Australia Rules.
14. EA Dress code will apply.
15. Yards and stables must be cleaned before departure with waste being placed in designated areas otherwise the Showgrounds will charge you a cleaning fee
16. Manure and hay must be picked up and placed in the signed manure area.
17. *1 Class 21: Off the Track Thoroughbreds must enter this class to be eligible for off the track best performed point scored. OTTB High Point rug kindly donated by the Kemp Racing Stables.
18. *2 Class 22: Interschool Riders. Classes noted as Interschool qualifiers are open to everyone but may be used as qualifiers by Interschool riders (refer conditions below).
19. *3 Riders competing in classes 105cm and above in height must hold current competitor membership with EA. All horses competing in these classes must be life registered with EA and have current Jumping Licence. Riders will be expected to provide copies of membership docs and Jumping Licence at time of nomination. Prize money may not be paid until documents are sighted by a member of the Organising Committee.
20. Neither the organising committee or the Toowoomba Jump Club, (thereinafter referred to as 'Organiser' accepts any liability for any accidental damage, loss, injury or illness to horse, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property. Damage to any third party by anyone at the competition will be the responsibility of the adult involved or the parents or guardians if those who cause any damage.
21. In an event of horse movement restrictions each participant will be responsible for veterinary care, maintenance and cost of their horse/s including feeding and watering for the time of such restriction.
22. Competitors are reminded that Medication Control (swabbing) can occur at any event run under Equestrian Australia rules and regulations.
23. **Dogs are permitted on grounds but must always be on a leash. Dogs are not permitted in the arena or warm up areas.**

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR INTERSCHOOL RIDERS

1. This event is being conducted under the rules as per the IQ Handbook 2021 and EA and FEI Rules where applicable. It is your responsibility to read your Handbook and be aware of these rules.
2. Riders & Horses must be registered with the Equestrian Qld.
3. **IQ qualifiers are SUNDAY only - 1 class per height may be used as an IQ qualifier.**
4. Interschool riders must enter Class 22 (no fee) when you are nominating.

INFORMATION FOR THE TSHA COMPETITOR

To be eligible for TSHA classes your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book. No part bred thoroughbreds will be eligible. To compete in the thoroughbred only classes you must purchase a competition licence with the TSHA through Global Entries Online.

The licence costs \$ 55 and runs for a calendar year from the date you purchased it. The licence can be obtained by logging into www.globalentriesonline.com.au

- Go to the 'Manage Horses" page
- Click on the "TSHA licence" button and fill in the details
- If you don't already have an account with Global Entries it is simple to create one and then follow the instructions above.

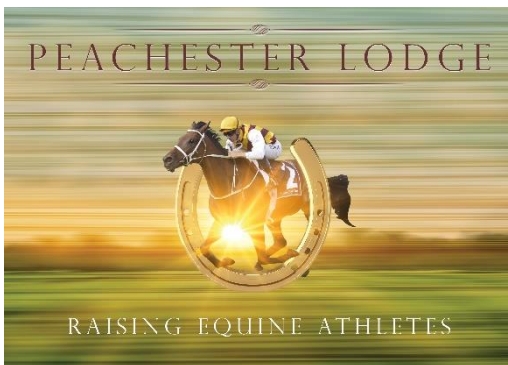


You must provide a microchip number. If this is not possible please provide your horse's race name and/or their breeding (dam and sire). If you are having trouble finding the information please send us an email and we can help you info@thoroughbredsporthorse.com.au. Licence enquiries Nicole Poetsch 0418 683 802 and for general enquiries Krissy Harris 0459 168 782.

The licence fee is for competition purposes only and is not proof of ownership. Any prize money will be paid to the winning rider. Connections of the horse must organise the prize money split, if any, between themselves. Any horses and riders competing in the TSHA Thoroughbred classes 1.05m and over must also hold EA registration.

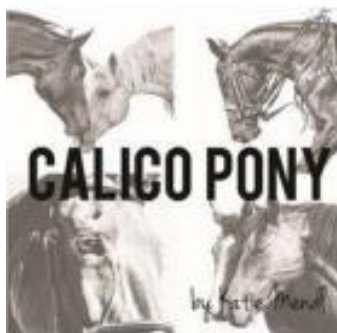
